DESCRIPTION

The Chicago based baritone, Brandan Sanchez performes the song cycle con Antonio Machado by Joaquin Rodrigo with Nathan Fischer. Shortly following the performance of the cycle Nathan and Brandan recorded the work in full. It is the first recording of the song cycle in full with guitar.

Rodrigo was inspired by literature, which played an important role in his output of song repertoire. As the title of this set suggests, these songs are a shared experience with Antonio Machado and his poetry. The symbolism in the texts will transport you to the landscapes of the blue hills and the snow covered fields of Soria, the green pine groves, the drab holm oaks and the land of the upper Duero. They sing repeatedly of roses and mild April afternoons, of a lover with a childlike voice, who was wrenched away by death, so early and so still.

DESCRIPTION

Presented here are three short excerpts from the guitar concerto. Dedicated to Nathan Fischer, Las Guitarras Azules was commissioned with assistance from the Howard Hanson Institute for American Music and the Fromm Foundation. Aaron Travers based the work on a poem by Pablo Neruda called Las Guitarras Azules and implemented idiomatic flamenco writing adapted to his personal composition style. The work is in five movements:

DESCRIPTION

DESCRIPTION



DESCTIPTION

A Falling Loop is a multimedia production created as a means to strengthen our global community, to engage Midwest rural communities, and to pair animation with new music to make new music more accessible to audiences. Engaging isolated Midwest rural communities to participate in *A Falling Loop* included collecting drawings and audio from community members. The images collected were reimagined and brought to life by animator Ida Lasic. According to Ida, "in A Falling Loop, community drawings of the flora and fauna of home life were taken into the 3D plane, transforming them into the textures of wild nature from the dancing stickmen, to the corn, to the vast pale blue fields". Audio was collected from more than 40 guitarists, and composer Miles Friday explained that in the process of electronic composition, "the guitar was sampled and synthesized into new digital landscapes and rhythmic eruptions" to accompany the acoustic guitars.
